Join our community center partners in developing opportunities for Allston-Brighton residents:

St. Elizabeth's Medical Center will expand its local health screenings, health education classes and support programs. Key components of this programming will include the REACH (Resources Education Advocacy Connections Hope) Program, which provides developmental support programs and resources for children and families, and the WIC (Women, Infants and Children) Program, which will offer health and nutrition classes for local families. Additionally, St. Elizabeth's will work with PSF, the YMCA and other local organizations to develop prevention-based community health programs, screenings and lectures aimed at addressing the health needs of the Allston-Brighton community.

Little Sprouts, a nationally recognized leader in early education, will operate a pre-school that will serve 140 local children. A key component of the Little Sprouts program includes curriculum materials developed by Brighton-based public broadcasting leader **WGBH**. Little Sprouts operates 11 other schools in Massachusetts and is accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children. The partnership between PSF, Little Sprouts and WGBH will be augmented by having **Wheelock College** serve on the advisory board for the pre-school programs.
