The following was jointly released by the PSF and the Archdiocese of Boston on June 11, 2005:

The Archdiocese of Boston and the Presentation School Foundation (PSF) announced that Archbishop Sean O'Malley will meet with representatives of the PSF on Monday, June 13th at 3 PM at the Chancery, 2121 Commonwealth Avenue, Brighton, MA.

The purpose of the meeting is to hold substantive discussions regarding the future of Our Lady of the Presentation School building, including a review of PSF's proposal to purchase the building, and to review the needs of the Archdiocese. Both parties seek an expeditious resolution that benefits the Allston-Brighton community, the City of Boston, and the Archdiocese.

Additionally, Archbishop O'Malley announced that there will be a morning session at Our Lady of the Presentation School on Monday, June 13th from 8-10 am. Parents can bring their children to the school for the 8am start and meet them for the 10am dismissal at which time the students will take their personal belongings with them.

The Archdiocese recognizes that the future of the Our Lady of the Presentation School building is of vital interest to the Allston-Brighton community.
